



The surrounding outline is the standard shape of a classical guitar bridge. I suggest you re-measure and cut out this center square to fit closely around your guitar's bridge - the more perfect the fit, the more your guitar top will be protected from the process of changing the strings. Cut along the center line above so you can apply and remove the guard around the guitar strings. Using a ruler and a razor blade on a cutting board is a good way to ensure the precision of this bridge cut-out, but the meticulous use of sharp scissors can be just as accurate.

Place this cardstock cut-out around your bridge to protect the guitar each time you change strings.
